Support for scholarships, bursaries, awards and prizes rewards academic excellence while making university education a reality for many students.

Endowment – Helping Forever

- By establishing an endowment, you are helping forever. Your donation will be invested and kept intact. The interest it produces each year (4%) will be used to help students advance on the issues you care about.
- You can also increase the impact of your gift by taking advantage of federal provisions on charitable gifts of publicly-listed securities. By establishing your endowment through a transfer of securities rather than cash, you can eliminate the capital gains tax otherwise payable.

Scholarships, Bursaries, Awards and Prizes

- **Scholarship:** Awarded to students for academic excellence. Scholarships are awarded to students entering or returning to university within a particular discipline. A minimum of \$25,000 in donations will establish a named permanent scholarship of \$1000 per year.
- **Bursary:** Assists students with demonstrated financial need. A minimum of \$12,500 in endowed donations will establish a named permanent bursary of \$500 per year.
- **Award:** Assists students with financial need *and* strong academic standing. A minimum of \$25,000 in endowed donations will establish a named permanent award of \$1,000 per year.
- **Prize:** Awarded by an academic department, based upon criteria such as commitment to learning, leadership, or other achievements. A minimum of \$12,500 in endowed donations will establish a named permanent prize of \$500 per year.

An endowed scholarship, bursary, award, or prize can be named in honour of a friend or loved one. They can also be designated for undergraduate or graduate students, or for specific programs.

Annual Support to Students

Scholarships, awards, bursaries and prizes may also be funded through an expendable gift. In this case, the entire amount of the gift is distributed over a finite period of time. A minimum commitment of five years is required, and must meet the above amounts: scholarships and awards must be at least \$1,000 per year, while bursaries and prizes must be at least \$500 per year.
