Robert W. F. Stephenson Leadership Award

The Robert W.F. Stephenson Prize for Excellence in Student Governance was established by the Alumni Association in honour of the late Robert Stephenson upon the completion of his term as chair of Trent University's Board of Governors. Mr.

Stephenson was the first alumnus to hold the position of chair. Valued at \$500, the prize, which recognizes understanding student leaders, was first awarded in 1995.
