The David Glassco Prize was established in 2013 to honour the late David Glassco, a long-time faculty member in the Department of English Literature and former principal of Champlain College. Professor Glassco's impact extended beyond the classroom to include contributions to athletics, theatre, and music, both on campus and in the wider community. Valued at \$1,000, the prize recognizes a student who demonstrates exceptional generosity of spirit through involvement in activities such as music, athletics, or theatre within the Trent and Peterborough communities. The award celebrates the important role of student engagement and leadership in enriching campus and community life..
